

Children's Liturgy of the Word

Three Sundays each month at 9:30 Mass volunteer celebrants gather the children of the parish to hear and discuss scripture readings at age appropriate levels. Conversations focus on what the Word of God means to them and how they can apply it to their daily life. Children old enough to listen without parental supervision up thru 1st grade attend "Little Church" in the vestibule. Children in 2nd grade, until they decide to remain with their parents in "big church", attend "Middle Church" in the reconciliation room opposite Little Church in the vestibule. One Sunday each month we celebrate a true family Mass and children stay with their parents. The celebrant at that Mass will frequently call the children up around the altar to hear a homily geared towards them. At all 9:30 Masses the children are invited to join the celebrant at the altar for the Blessing of the Gifts.

Our volunteer Children's Liturgy celebrants choose which group, Little or Middle, they prefer to lead. The current schedule has each Leader teaching about once every other month. It is one of the most rewarding ways to serve the parish community as the children are our future and they always have the most amazing insights into the Gospel. New Leaders are given instruction and guidance on simple lesson plans; attend a couple sessions with experienced leaders, then get to spread the word on their own when they are ready.
